



### **Gene Haas Foundation Scholarship (machining)**

Program details: Gene Haas has awarded Morris County Vocational School District a total of \$10,000 to award to students enrolled in career-oriented programs for 2016-17. Award amounts will vary depending upon the applicant pool.

#### *Selection Criteria:*

- Programs that qualify for this scholarship are: Foundations in Fabrication & NIMS Machining Level 1.
- Your self-funded tuition must be paid in full for either class.
- Candidates must successfully complete the program; and for NIMS Level 1 candidates must have achieved a Level 1 NIMS safety certification & a NIMS machining certification.
- Complete and submit to Continuing Ed office by January 30th the MCVSD/CE Machining Scholarship Application – this application is available on our website.
- Completion and certifications will be verified by administration.
- Scholarship recipients will be issued a tuition refund check in the amount of the award which will be based on the pool of qualified students. The scholarship amount may not exceed the total student-funded cost of the program.
